JUL 19: COPENHAGEN, DENMARK

Depart 7PM

JUL 20: CRUISING THE NORTH SEA

JUL 21: BERGEN, NORWAY

Arrive 8AM—Depart 6PM

Surrounded by seven round, forested hills and seven majestic fjords, Bergen is at the heart of the fjord district and a city of both natural beauty and fascinating history. Vibrant timber houses dot the hillsides and winding cobblestone streets are reminiscent of a past linked to Viking sagas and the Hanseatic League.

JUL 22: ALESUND, NORWAY

Arrive 8AM—Depart 7PM

As Norway's largest fish-exporting harbor and, ironically, built on a narrow fish-hook-shaped peninsula, Alesund boasts beauty and distinction alike. Destroyed by fire in 1904 and quickly rebuilt in the Art Nouveau style, its winding streets, gargoyle-clad buildings and romantic turrets are entrenched in the mystery of Nordic mythology.

JUL 23: TRONDHEIM, NORWAY

Arrive 8AM—Depart 7PM

Originally called "Nidaros" when it was founded in the 10th century by Viking King Olav Trygvason, Trondheim is today a spirited university town at the mouth of the Nidelva River. As Norway's original capital, Trondheim preserves its ancient history at Nidaros Cathedral—Scandinavia's largest Gothic-style church—built over the grave of St. Olav, Norway's patron saint, and at the 12th-century Archbishop's Palace Museum, filled with fascinating sculptures from the Middle Ages.

JUL 24: CRUISING THE NORWEGIAN SEA

JUL 25: HAMMERFEST, NORWAY

Arrive 8AM—Depart 4PM

Proudly claiming to be the world's northernmost town, Hammerfest is known for its multicolored homes edging a superb natural harbor, and for its gateway to the pristine arctic scenery of the North Cape. In town, visitors can admire the attractive, avant-garde Hammerfest Kirke (Church) or take in remarkable coastal views atop Salen ridge.

JUL 26: MURMANSK, RUSSIA

Arrive 12PM—Depart 9PM

Positioned on Russia's Kola Peninsula and surrounded by tundra, lakes and forests, the largest city north of the Arctic Circle draws visitors with its revered Regional Arts Museum and glorious St. Nicholas Church, named for the patron saint of sailors. An important Russian naval base, Murmansk honors Soviet defenders from the Great Patriotic War with several monuments strewn throughout the city, including "Alyosha," affording unparalleled views from its hilltop setting.

JUL 27: CRUISING THE WHITE SEA

JUL 28: SOLOVETSKY ISLANDS, RUSSIA

Arrive 8AM

An archipelago located in the Onega Bay of the White Sea, the Solovetsky Islands hold haunting history as the former home of a tsarist-era penal colony and one of the cruelest Soviet prison camps. The 15th-century Solovetsky Monastery stands among the islands' pristine scenery, marked by rocky headlands, coves and wind-swept forests. *Overnight on ship at the Solovetsky Islands.*

JUL 29: SOLOVETSKY ISLANDS, RUSSIA

Depart 7PM

JUL 30: ARCHANGEL, RUSSIA

Arrive 8AM—Depart 7PM

Established in 1583, on the order of Ivan the Terrible to become Russia's first major commercial port, today Archangel or Arkhangelsk is known as the "Gateway to the Arctic." Step back into medieval Russia at the nearby Museum of Wooden Architecture, "Malye Korely," the largest open-air museum of its kind in Europe, complete with centuries-old churches, bell towers, windmills and watermills.

JUL 31: CRUISING THE BARENTS SEA

AUG 1: NORTH CAPE (HONNINGSVAG), NORWAY

Arrive 8AM—Depart 5PM

One of the world's most northerly villages, this tiny pastel fishing port framed by stark mountain scenery is a popular destination for visitors bound for the rugged Nordkapp (North Cape). From desolate tundra landscapes to steep, rocky cliffs and breathtaking seascapes, the North Cape's arctic beauty is truly unforgettable.

AUG 2: CRUISING THE NORWEGIAN SEA

AUG 3: KRISTIANSUND, NORWAY

Arrive 9AM—Depart 7PM

Draped across a band of rocky islands, the charming cod-fishing town of Kristiansund is a summertime tourist hotspot with its bustling fish market, Fiskebrygga. This historic port is your gateway to the region's welcoming island villages, gorgeous fjords, steep mountains, and the spectacular Atlantic Road—touted as Norway's "Construction of the Century."

AUG 4: GEIRANGER (GEIRANGERFJORD), NORWAY

Arrive 7AM—Depart 1PM

Geiranger is a quaint village situated in a small valley at the inland tip of Geirangerfjord, which is unabashedly called "the most beautiful fjord in the world." Its snow-capped mountains rise from the sapphire waters below and leafy forests blanket the surrounding hillsides.

AUG 4: HELLESYLT, NORWAY

Arrive 3PM—Depart 5PM

Hellesylt, Norway's oldest Viking port, is nestled deep in the majestic fjord country, at the head of the scenic Sunnlyvsfjord and edged by steep, jagged cliffs, pristine lakes and verdant forests—a scene so dramatic it inspired Henrik Ibsen's early play *Brand*.

AUG 5: CRUISING THE NORTH SEA

AUG 6: AALBORG, DENMARK

Arrive 8AM—Depart 6PM

Located on the Northern Jutland peninsula, Denmark's fourth-largest city was founded by the Vikings in the 10th century and has grown into a commercial center and popular university town.
